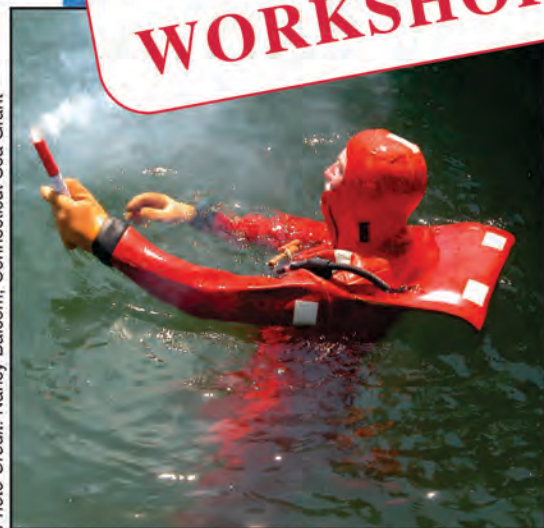

DIRECTIONS (Traveling from western Long Island)
